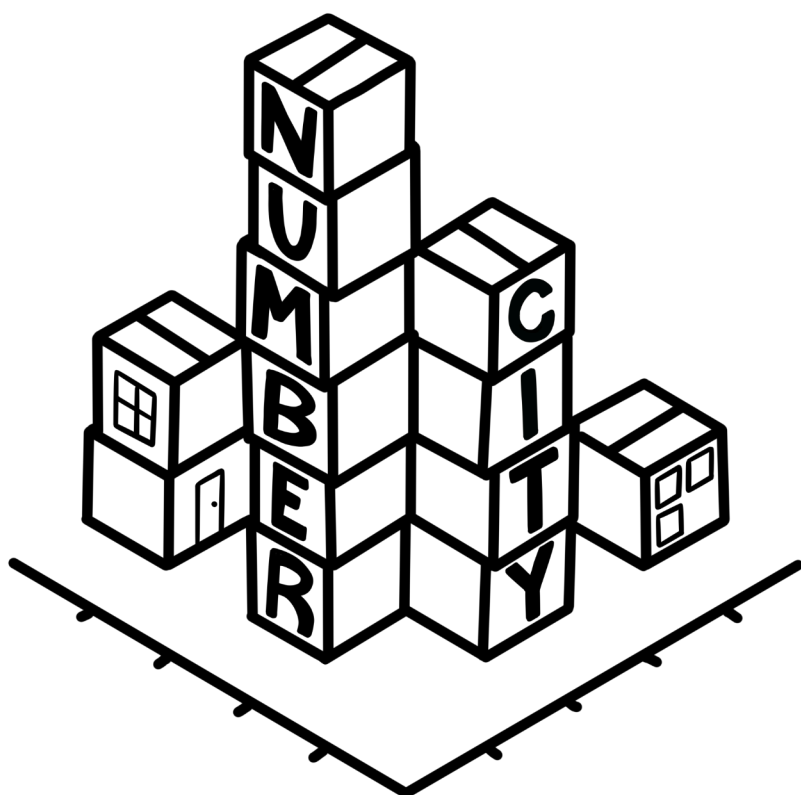


Imagine Number City is a real city...

- What kind of building does each box (or stack of boxes) represent? What are the tall stacks of boxes?
- What kind of things might people who live in this city believe, or tell each other, about the meaning of living in particular box numbers, or living high up or low down in a stack?
- Find a pair of single-box houses close together. Who lives in these houses?
- Which areas of Number City do not contain any buildings? Why doesn't anyone want to build there?
- How do you move house in Number City? How much might the different houses cost?
- If you lived in Number City, where would you want to live - and why? What would your daily routine be?
- What routes might people who live in the city choose to go for a walk? Where are they walking to, and why?
